TO: **All Coaches**

RE: **Required Concussion Training**

A new State Senate Bill passed in early 2011 which requires ALL COACHES to complete a concussion recognition education course annually.

In compliance with the Senate Bill:

**(b) EACH PRIVATE CLUB OR PUBLIC RECREATION FACILITY AND EACH ATHLETIC LEAGUE THAT SPONSORS YOUTH ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES SHALL REQUIRE EACH VOLUNTEER COACH FOR A YOUTH ATHLETIC ACTIVITY AND EACH COACH WITH WHOM THE CLUB, FACILITY, OR LEAGUE DIRECTLY CONTRACTS WITH, FORMALLY ENGAGES, OR EMPLOYS WHO COACHES A YOUTH ATHLETIC ACTIVITY TO COMPLETE AN ANNUAL CONCUSSION RECOGNITION EDUCATION COURSE.**

Upon completion of the course **all** coaches who will be coaching on any sport will be **required** to submit the completion certificate to the supervisor of the program, by the **first practice date** in order to coach in the City of Greeley Culture, Parks, and Recreation Youth Sports Program.
