

Draft Rules

- Each captain will get a chance to pick a player for their team.
 - Unless they pick a carpool group, in that case they use their picks for future rounds to come
- Each captain can protect 2 core players. These core players cannot be drafted by other teams.
 - Captains must submit an email to Program Coordinator the day before the draft.
 - Core players are allowed to be changed up to the last day before the draft at 6pm.
 - Those players being submitted as core players must be aware that they are being protected by that captain and grant their prior consent. If two captains attempt to protect the same player, league administration will contact that player prior to the draft to determine his team preference. The other captain will then be notified and allowed to submit a replacement player.
 - The captain does not count as one of the two protected players.
- The team that finished last during regular season will get to pick first, then the team that finished second to last in the regular season will pick second, etc., until the team who finished first in regular season play picks last. If there is enough guys for a new team to form that new captain will get last pick in the draft.
- League administration reserves the right to make team adjustments after the draft to resolve conflicts and achieve parity during the first three weeks.
- If players sign up after draft the hockey director will assign them to the team he sees as best fit.
