



2020 Fall Youth Soccer
Safe to Play Guidance

Personal Protection Equipment

- Players are encouraged to wear a mask before and after practices and games.
- Coaches and officials are strongly encouraged to wear a mask and required to practice social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times.
- City of Greeley staff are required to take their temperature each day and wear masks when interacting within 6 feet of participants, coaches, spectators and other staff.
- Masks are strongly encouraged for all spectators.

COVID Guidelines

- Stay home if you or anyone in your household are sick or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Each field will have a maximum group size of 25 participants (does not include coaches and officials).
- Spectators are permitted for youth sports. Members from different households must maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance from each other.
- Each coach will be required to track attendance for every practice, team gathering and game. Attendance must be submitted weekly to City of Greeley staff to support local public health contact tracing efforts if exposures occur.

Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the supervisor table at game sites, however participants/spectators are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer to all practices and games.
- City of Greeley staff will sanitize sports equipment after each game.
- Teams are not permitted to bring snacks or drinks to share.

Social Distancing

- No handshakes/high fives before, during, or after the game.
- Teams warm up in designated areas away from other teams.
- Parents/spectators are expected to wait in their cars until the game is about to start and all parents/spectators/participants from the previous game are in their vehicles.
- Players/coaches can enter the field five minutes prior to game time assuming all previous participants and coaches have vacated the field.
- All coaches, players, and spectators are to leave the facility immediately following their game. No post-game socializing is allowed at the fields.
- Minimum 6 foot spacing in waiting lines in common areas.
- Only two people at a time in the restroom.
- Team benches/gathering areas will be on opposite sides of the field.
- Spectator areas will be a minimum of ten feet from the playing field/team members.

Miscellaneous

- No sharing personal equipment. Participants are encouraged to use their own personal equipment during practice.
- The City of Greeley reserves the right to modify leagues to help participants stay healthy and practice social distancing.
- If at any time the City of Greeley deems it unsafe for the league to continue, the league may be canceled.
