



Complete your NFHS Concussion Training Certification

In compliance with State Senate Bill 11-040 (Jake Snakenberg Youth Concussion Act), we require that all our City of Greeley Coaches complete an online concussion training certification annually to ensure a better, safer experience for our players, coaches and parents. Coaches are required to complete and submit the certification prior to the first practice. Please follow the instructions below to complete and submit your 2021 certification:

1. Log on to the website: <https://nfhslearn.com/>
2. Click on "Concussion Courses" on the homepage.
3. Next click on the "Concussion in Sports" tab and "view course".
4. You will see "Order Course" at the top of the page, click this tab and the site will ask you to sign in. You will need create an account and password.
5. Once you have registered and signed in, click on "Order Course". Please note this is a Free Course and will not require any form of payment.
6. The site will ask you if this course will be completed by you or others. Click the option, "Myself".
7. Select "Colorado" as the state you are being certified.
8. Complete your order at no cost.
9. Finally, click on the course access and complete your certification.
