



Woodshop Wood Turning Intro Class Friday | February 16 | 9 - 1:30 p.m.

Wednesday | February 28 | 9 - 1:30 p.m. Learn the basics of wood-turning, including the operation of both of the lathes. We will review the lathes, various options for holding wood on the lathe and the use of carbide tools. You will be introduced to the 2 most common disciplines of wood-turning. spindles and bowls. This is a long, hands on class that requires you to work at the lathe for a majority of the time. Participants are required to wear either a full-face shield or goggles while working on the lathes; both available in the shop. This is not a project class, do not expect to walk out with a finished work piece. Deadline February 14; min 2. max 2
